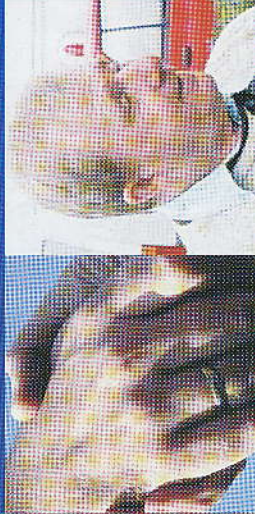

The JERSEY CHESHIRE HOME was founded in 1983 and provides residential care for twenty-one disabled residents and day care services to many others. It is the only residential Home in Jersey dedicated to the long-term care of the disabled and without it, the Island would face major capital and running costs to provide these essential services.

To date the Jersey Cheshire Home Team has raised substantial funds, most of which has been invested in the construction and running of the Home for Jersey's disabled. We are not funded by Leonard Cheshire.

We keep the Home at the centre of our attention. Our key objective is that the Home lives up to our hopes for a brighter future for all residents and the many people associated with it.

We strive to make the Jersey Cheshire Home a wonderful place to live in for all our residents, but that is not enough. It must be an effective place from which we can make a real change to the lives of the disabled in Jersey. This requires the energy and commitment of hundreds of people. Our funding is critically dependent on our supporters who, in sharing our vision give us financial security and, provide the most valuable gift of all, independence. Able people take independence for granted but not so the disabled. In an era when the individual is growing in importance the disabled need even greater support. It is you that can give the disabled in Jersey, the independence they seek.

All money raised by Jersey Cheshire is used to further our charitable aim in the areas of care, respite, day-care, hydrotherapy, specialist exercise and occupational therapy all with the aim of giving independence to our disabled Island people who are in need of care. Your support will lead to further investment in the fabric of Jersey Cheshire - more respite rooms, more facilities or more carers. It will also take the form of more education and more outreach to the disabled, on our doorstep in Jersey.
